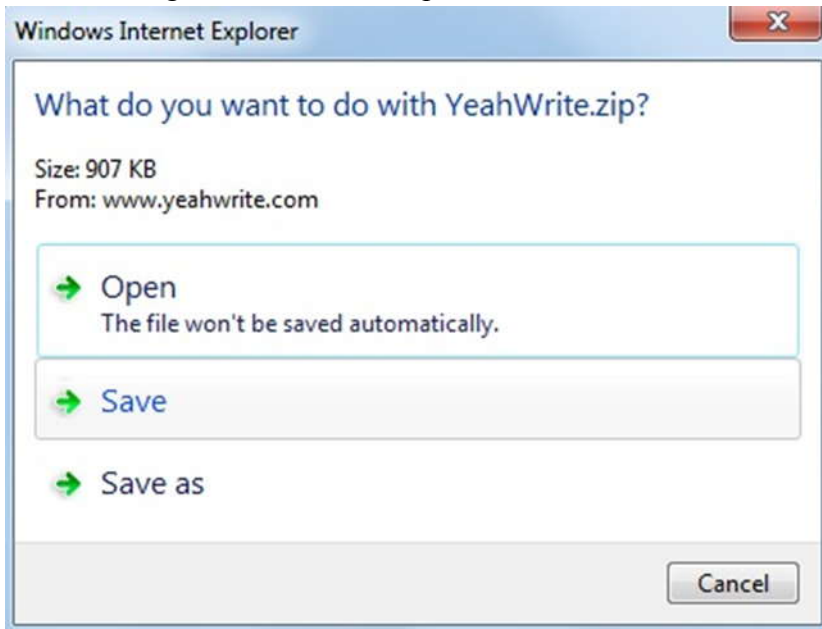
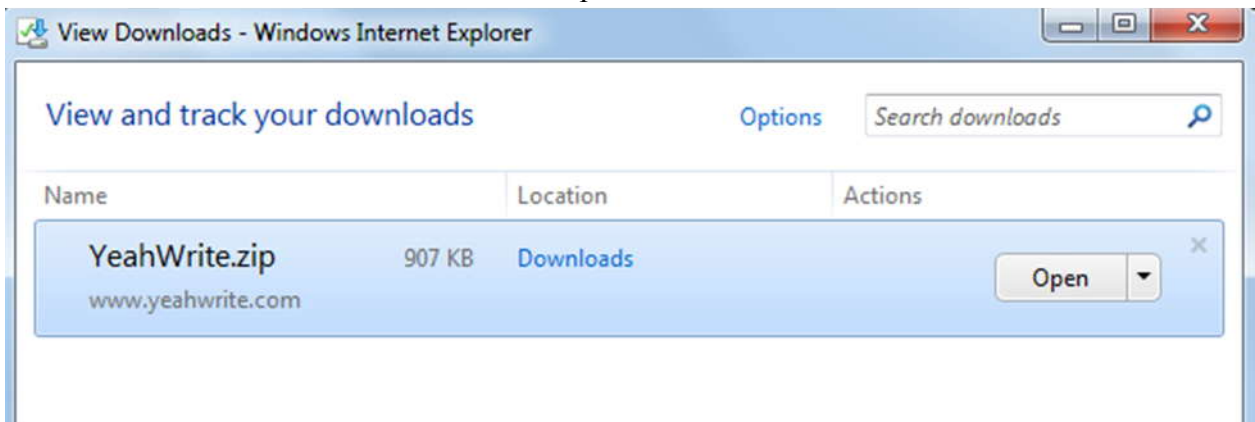


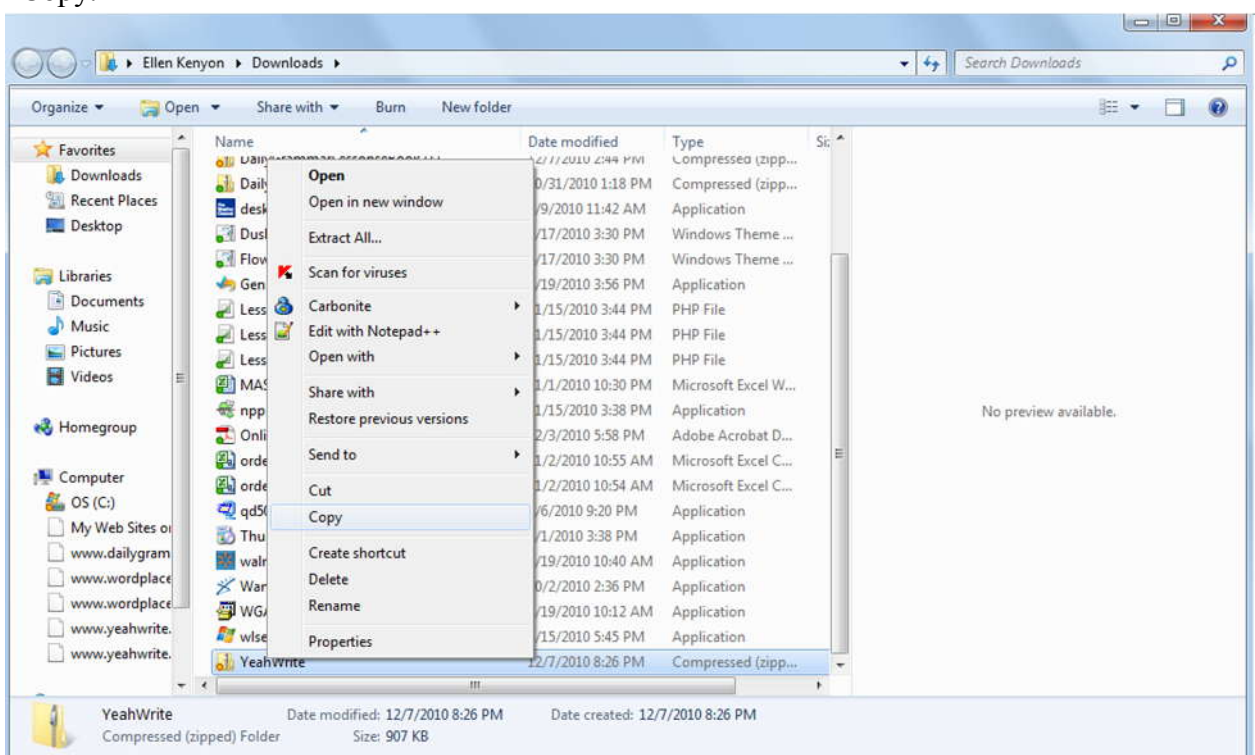
1. On the Yeah Write download page (<http://www.yeahwrite.com/downexe.shtml>), click the “[Download Yeah Write for Windows 7 & Vista](#)” link.
2. You will be given a number of options from Windows 7. Choose “Save.”



3. Click “Downloads” next to the YeahWrite.zip file.



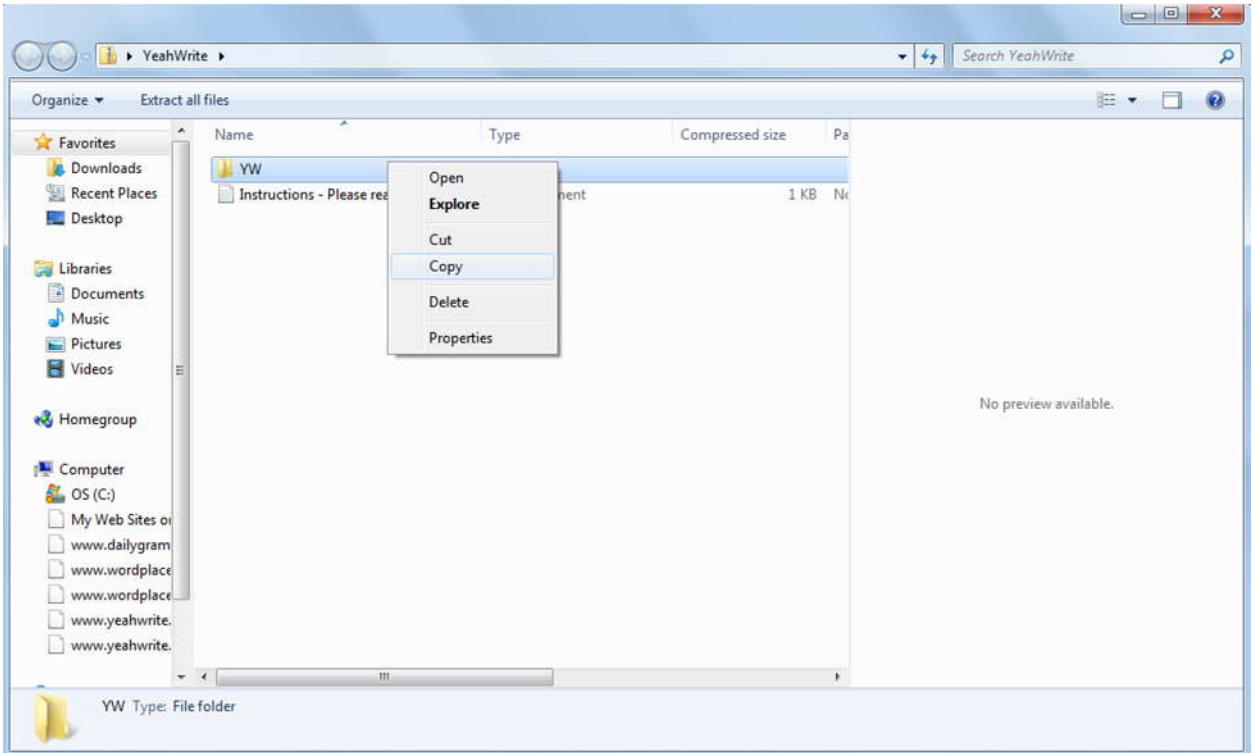
4. You are now in your Downloads folder. Right-click on the YeahWrite.zip file and select “Copy.”



5. Go to your Desktop. Right-click and select “Paste.” Now the YeahWrite.zip file is on your Desktop. Double-click on the YeahWrite.zip file to open the compressed folder.



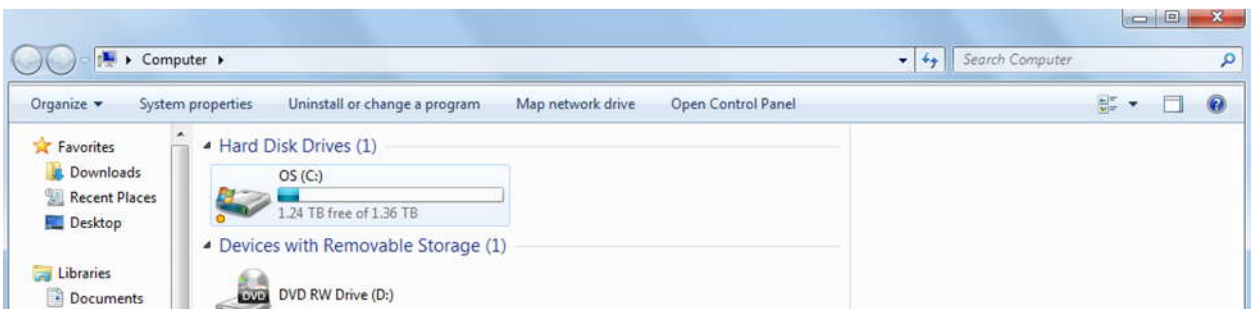
6. Right-click on the folder called “YW” and select “Copy.”



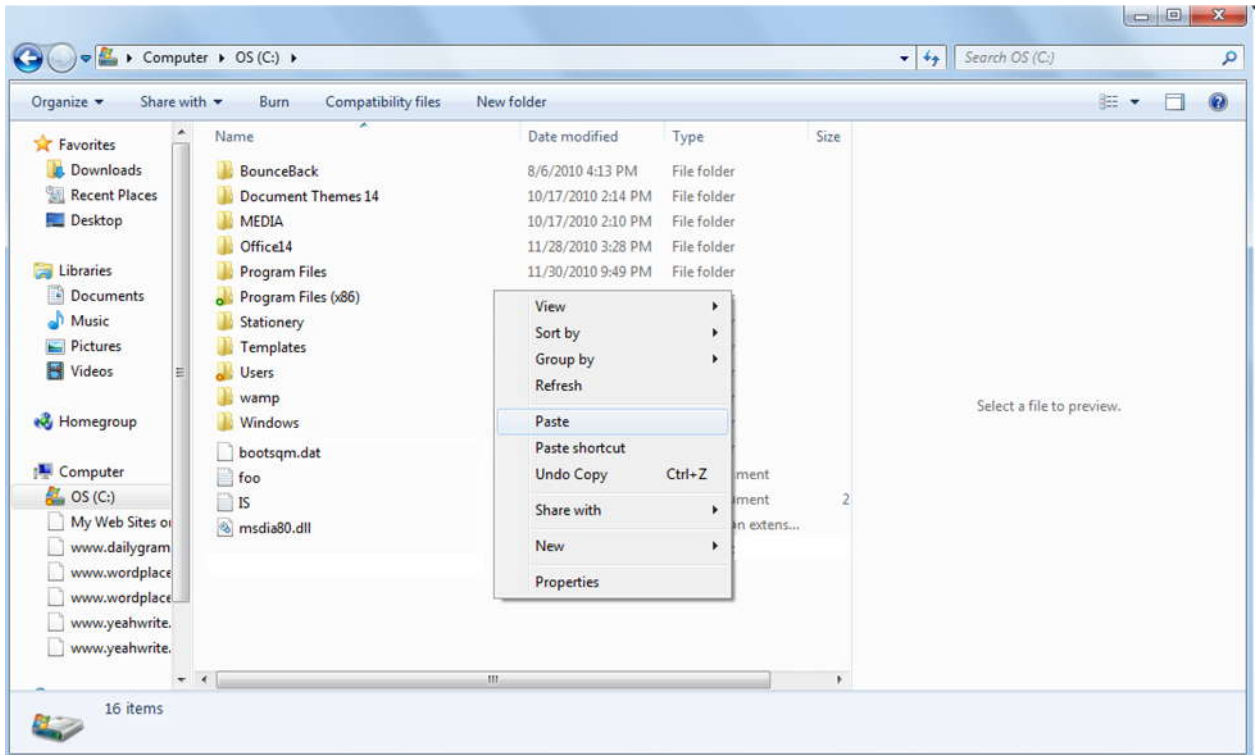
7. Double-click on your computer icon on your Desktop or click on the “Computer” icon in your Start Menu. Now you can view your hard drive.



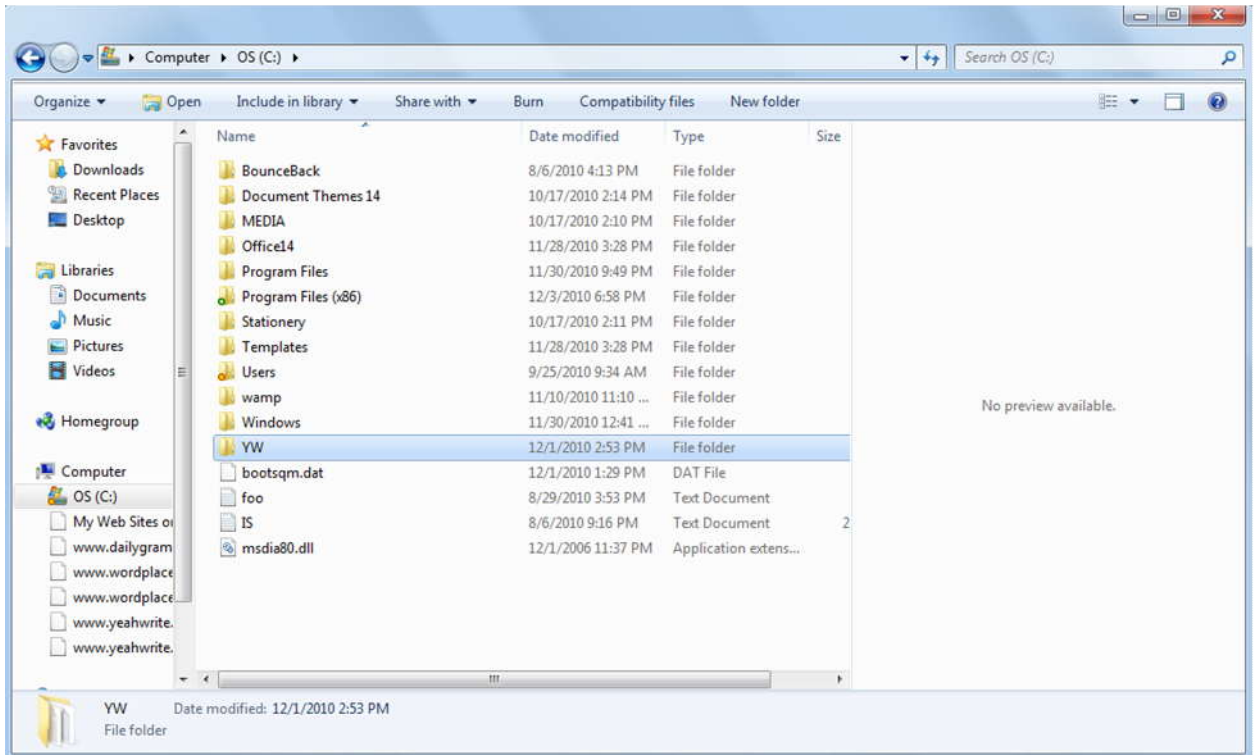
8. Double-click on your C drive (or whatever main hard drive you have) to open and view the contents.



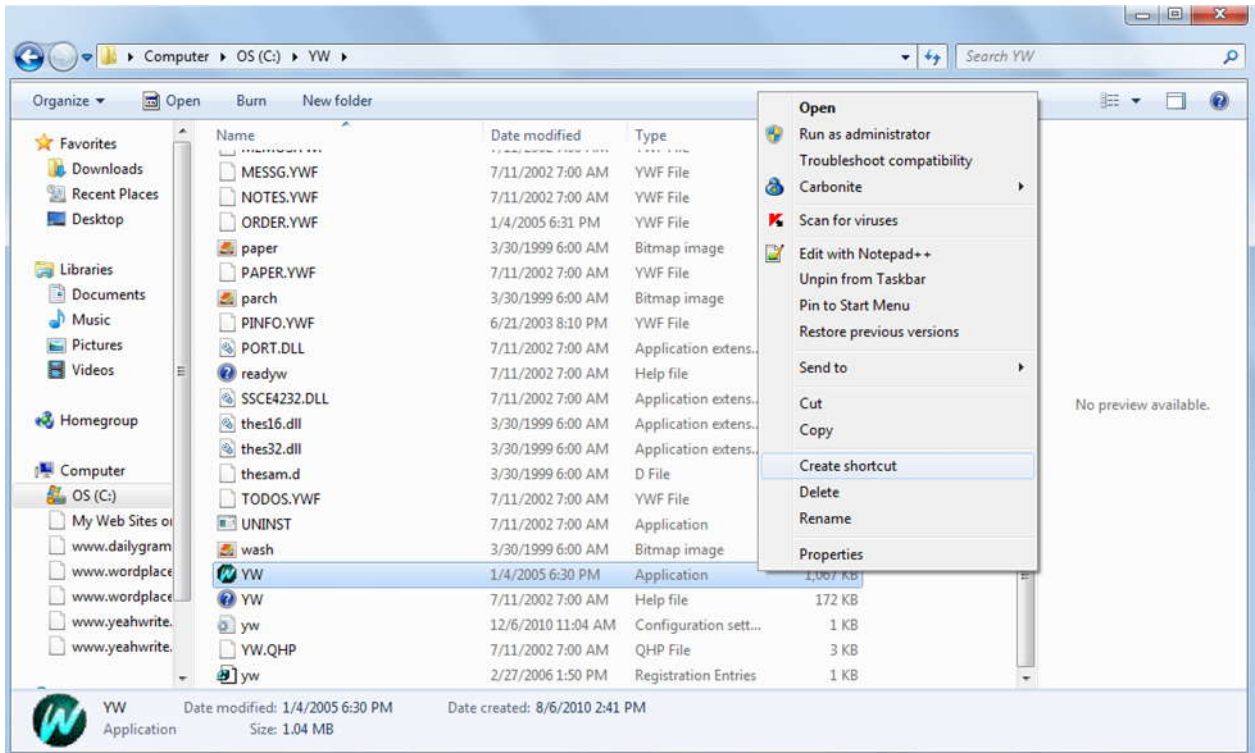
9. Right-click on a white space (so you do not select any files) and select “Paste.”



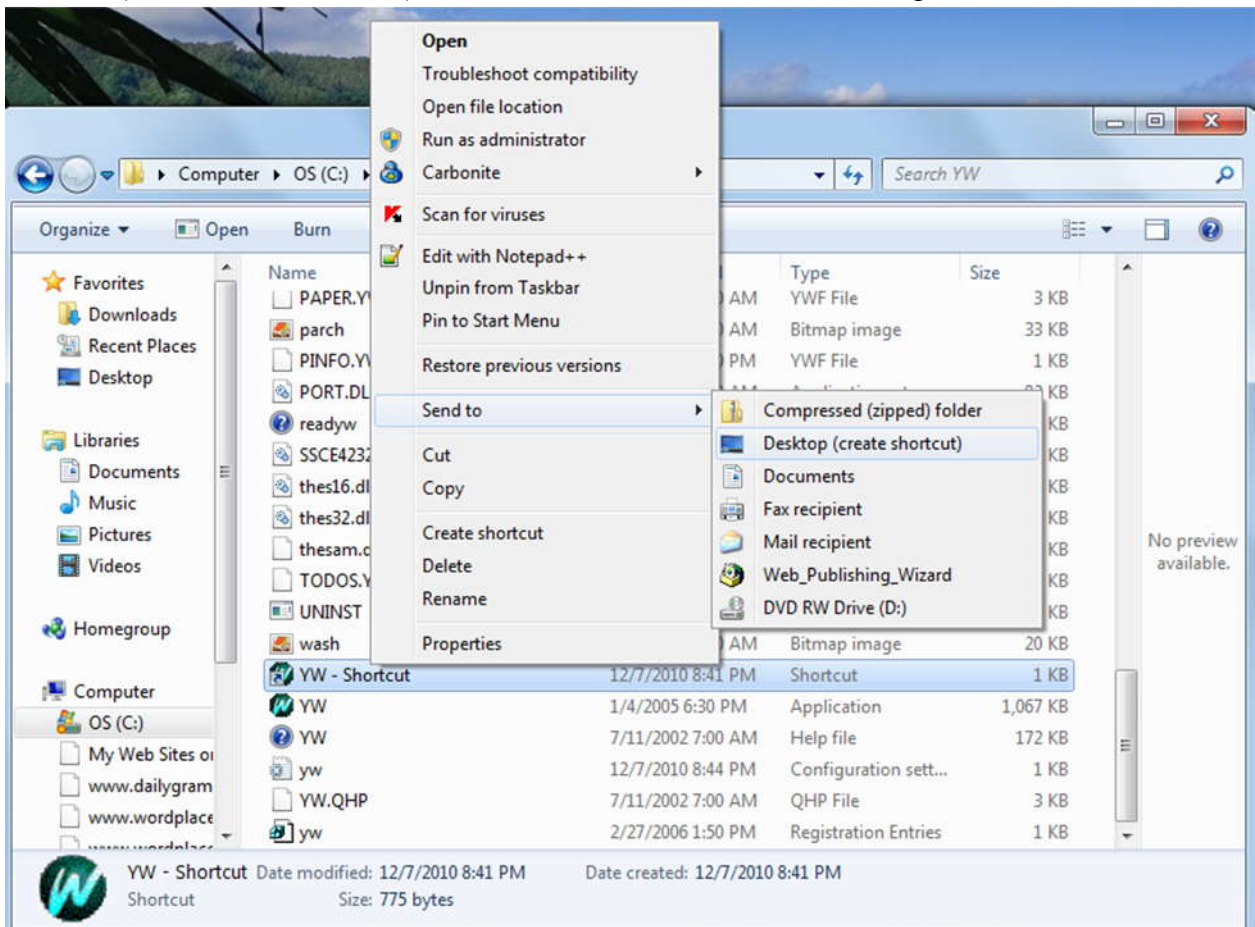
10. The “YW” folder is now located at C:\YW. Double click on the “YW” folder.



11. Locate a file in the “YW” folder that is called “YW” and is a file type known as an “Application.” Right click on the “YW” file and select “Create shortcut.”



12. The shortcut will now appear in the same folder where it was created. Right click the shortcut (called YW – Shortcut) and select “Send to” and then “Desktop.”



13. You now have a shortcut to start-up Yeah Write on your Desktop, just double-click. You can right-click the shortcut and rename it to whatever you want. You can also drag it and pin it to your taskbar.
